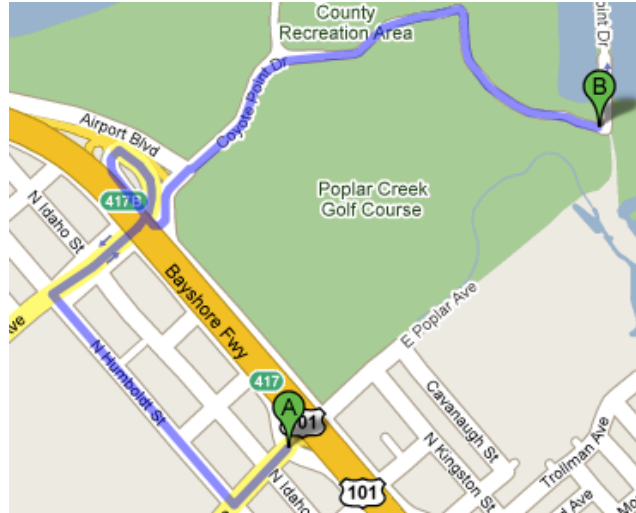

Directions:

Coming to Coyote Point from the **North** (San Francisco), use Highway 101 South.

- Take the Poplar Avenue exit.
- Turn right onto Humboldt until Peninsula Avenue.
- Turn right onto Peninsula Avenue.
- Go over the freeway, and then circle around and into the Park.



Coming to Coyote Point from the **South** (San Jose), use Highway 101 North.

- Take the Dore Avenue exit (417 A).
- Immediately turn left onto North Bayshore Boulevard.
- Turn right onto Coyote Point Drive to the park.
